

## Reciprocal Borrowing Within Consortiums

Consortium	Reciprocal Borrower Rules
Georgia Pines	All have a state card that can be used anywhere
ECRL (East Central Reg. Lib.- MN)	One card for all libraries
COOL - Ohio	They do not do reciprocal borrowing at this time - only a shared catalog
North Carolina Cardinal	Can use card at other libraries
Pioneer Library System ( NY)	One card for system
SAGE (Oregon)	Use home library card anywhere
LINC (Library Integrated Network Consortium - Il)	Can use home card but 1st at each library must show photo ID and library card.
ACLS (South Carolina Lends Consortium)	One card for system
LMxAC (Libraries of Middlesex Automation Consortium - NJ)	Part of PaLs Plus system Card from any member library can be used. Place a sticker on card after card holder has shown & verified ID
LYNX! (Idaho)	All participating libraries can use their library card at other libraries
BCCLS (NJ)	All cards of members OK
PaLsPlus (NJ)	Can use home library card at any consortium library
Merrimack Valley Library Consortium	Can use home library card at any consortium library
RAILS (Reaching Across Illinois Library System)	Can use home library card at RAILS libraries
PLAC (Public Library Access Card (In)	State Library card - costs \$65/year and can be used at any library in Indiana.
SWAN Consortium (il)	Can use home library card at any library
MAIN (Roxbury, Morris County)	Can use home library card at any library
Tampa Bay Library Consortium	Borrowers register at home library first but can use any

(FI)	library in consortium
Alaska Library Network	Can use a home library card or have a ARLIS card
Harrington Library Consortium (TX)	Have a Harrington Library Consortium card
Merlin (Northern Waters Library Service- Wisconsin)	Can use any Merlin Library members card
Minuteman Library Network (MA0)	Can use any member libraries' card
